The Advocacy Intern or Fellow will play a significant role in advancing the #Faith4ERA campaign to amplify faith support for the ERA. This role will involve responsibility for advocacy with executive and legislative branch officials.

Responsibilities

- Develop and maintain a thorough understanding of the Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) and the social movement in support of the ERA
- Create advocacy materials, such as letters, bill summaries, fact sheets, and infographics, for advocacy with executive and legislative officials.
- Coordinate, support and participate in advocacy meetings with executive branch officials and congressional staff

Monitor legislative developments and other relevant news on the ERA

Required Qualifications

- At least two years of college required; Bachelors' degree preferred; graduate education (in law, public policy, political science, etc.) welcome
- Background in human rights, civil rights, government relations, or policy advocacy preferred
- Strong oral and written communication and interpersonal skills
- Strong self-management and organizational skills; attention to detail
- Willingness and ability to prioritize Justice Revival
- Initiative, creativity, flexibility, and an entrepreneurial spirit
- A contagious passion for our cause
